BoekStart in childcare

Core

- BoekStart supports preschool/childcare in the field of reading promotion, by means of the collection and expertise of a library consultant
- Professionalizing the reading environment in childcare
- Reading promotion becomes part of the pedagogical policy and is included in the daycare programme








From BookStart tot Booksmart (Van den Berg, 2015)

- Does BoekStart influence shared reading at home?
- Does BoekStart have an effect on children's vocabulary development?
- Which children benefit most from BookStart?







Results: shared reading & vocabulary


- BookStart-parents know more babybooks
- BoekStart in general doesn't effect vocabulary
- If shared reading increases as a result of BookStart, children's vocabulary is more extensive at 15 and 22 months of age
- The effect increases with time







Results: temperament









Long-term effects of BookStart (De Bondt & Bus 2022)

- Is shared reading still more frequent amongst BookStart-parents after infancy?
- Do BookStart-children score higher on language, reading and math at age 5 to 6?
- What can BoekStart learn from other bookgifting programmes?







BookStart-parents vs. Non-BookStart-parents

Differences:

- Early start with reading
- · Library membership child
- Duration of reading session

Similarities:

- Frequency of shared reading
- Number of books at home
- Library visits







Longterm effects BoekStart

- BookStart-children with a difficult temperament still have higher language scores aged 5 to 6
- BoekStart doesn't affect math scores







Bookgifting programmes: Overall effects & differences

- BoekStart / BookStart
- Reach out and read doctor at child health clinic gives reading advise and books
- Imagination library form 0 to 5 years of age, every month a book







Boekgifting programmes: effects

- Enhanced reading environment at home
- Especially in low income families
 - → no differences between the programmes

- Increased reading interest and reading skills
 - → Reach out and read has the biggest effects







BoekStart: recommendations

- Promote participation in BoekStart for all parents. It also makes a difference for children of highly educated parents.
- Promote the participation of low-educated parents in BoekStart
- Make the importance of reading a structural part of conversations with parents at child health clinics.







BoekStart: recommendations in practice

- Expansion of the BookStartcoaches approach (home and healthcare)
- Pilot with two healthcare organizations with reach out and read elements (more time for supporting parents)











BoekStart: recommendations in practice

- Exploring the possibility of a second BookStart package for toddlers
- Multilingual reading material
- Increase the visibility of BoekStart through public campaigns such as Baby Book of the Year election and BoekStartday













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
